As a reminder, your Naviance username is your email address.

This past year, you completed the “Strength Explorer” survey in class. This survey assessed 10 talent themes and identified your top three strongest emerging talents. Upon completion of Strengths Explorer, you were provided with explanations of your top three themes and were given information on how to capitalize your success and discover what you need to do next to continue building on your strengths. This is interesting and helpful information as you look to create future post-secondary plans.

This October, you will have the option to take the PSAT at Bromfield, which many of you may have taken already as sophomores. Registration information will be distributed at the beginning of the year. The College Board has teamed up with Khan Academy to create free practice

resources for the new test, making it easier for students to achieve their personal best. These online resources generate individualized practice recommendations that meet students where they are in their learning and help them grow. Visit www.khanacademy.org/sat to get started. For those of you who took the PSATs this past October, there is a unique access code on your PSAT results, which will give you access to your full score report online. You can login to your College Board accounts to view your PSAT results.

We hope you continue to use Naviance for your college and career explorations throughout the summer into Junior year. Please remember to continue to update your resumé as well so you can keep track of everything you are involved in.
