MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Term Hours. Each term, members must complete four service hours and upload the signed term hour form to Google Classroom by the due date. **Hours not posted by the deadline will earn a strike.** If a member fails to complete hours for a given term during the following term, he or she will be dismissed from the chapter.

Leadership Project. In the year following a member's induction, he or she must complete a six-hour community service leadership project. In this project, the member must not only perform community service, but also take a leadership and organizing role in his or her service. Proposals must be approved in advance. **Proposals or reflections turned in late will receive a strike.** Any member who does not complete a leadership project by the end of the school year following his or her induction will be dismissed.

Maintaining Standards. Each member must consistently uphold the four pillars of scholarship, character, leadership, and service to remain a member of the Bromfield chapter in good standing. If a member falls below the minimum required GPA of a 3.30, he or she will be dismissed. If a member is involved in disciplinary action by the school administration, or given a bad report of character by a teacher or other school personnel, dismissal proceedings will be taken out against that student.

EARNING STRIKES

Once a student earns three strikes, he or she will be dismissed from NHS. Strike notices will be given out within fifteen days of any infraction.
