Members: The Academic Integrity Appeals Board consists of one administrator (Mr. Hoffman or Ms. Benoit), three teachers (Mr. Jones, Ms Chlapowski, and Mrs. Pierce), and three students: Kate Selig, Josh Canning, and Class of 2020 TBA.

Purpose: The Academic Integrity Appeals Board was created to provide an appeals process for students who feel they have been unjustly accused of cheating or plagiarism.

Process of Convening the Academic Integrity Appeals Board: When a student feels he/she has been unjustly accused of cheating or plagiarism, he can appeal to the Academic Integrity Appeals Board. The student will obtain and complete a form (below) that can be found in the main office. Once the form has been completed and submitted to Mr. Hoffman, a hearing will be scheduled.

Hearing Process: The administrator will conduct the hearing and be a voting member of the board. The board will first hear from the student. The student may bring anyone with him to the hearing who can help his defense, but he must make his own argument. The teacher will then present his case. The teacher may also bring anyone who can corroborate his version. It should be noted that both sides will not be present at the same time while addressing the board. After hearing both sides of the argument, the board may or may not call back either side for further questioning. The board will work towards consensus but will render a decision after deliberation whether or not consensus is reached.
