COURSE TITLE: Global Competency Certificate **Senior Seminar**

COURSE CREDIT & DURATION: 1/2- 1 credit, full year

DESCRIPTION: This course will serve as a capstone class for seniors currently accepted and enrolled in the Global Competency Certificate program (GCC). The course structure will include a combination of methods, including Socratic seminars and online discussion boards, meant to facilitate student driven discussions which reflect upon experiences in the GCC program. Active participation is expected. The senior seminar is also designed to guide students through program requirements, with special attention placed on GCC essay and capstone presentation, ensuring program goals are met by all students.
