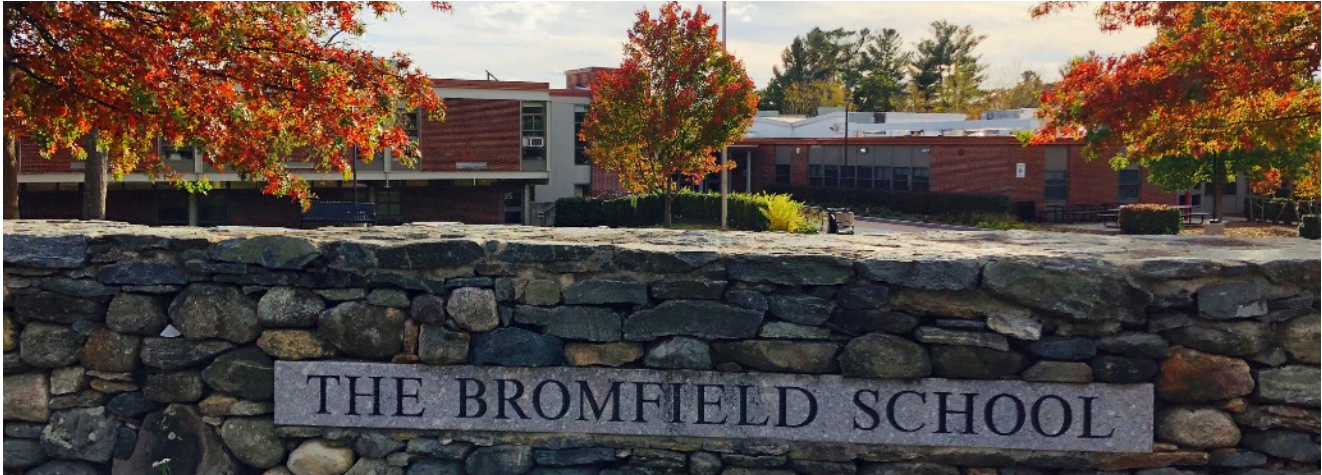

BROMFIELD BULLETIN
