- Google Classroom – You will be given a code to join a Google Classroom on the first day of school. Assignments, due dates, announcements, links, and resources will all be provided in you Google Classroom.

Classroom Expectations:

- Students are expected to arrive on time and prepared to work. This goes for Zoom classes as well.
- Active participation, questions, and mistakes are expected. (Yes, mistakes. Take a risk! We'll correct mistakes together.)
- Be "Responsible, Reasonable, and RESPECTFUL"!!!
- Hats, gum, and cell phones are not allowed!
- All school rules apply in my classroom (virtual and in-person).

Zoom Expectations:

- All Classroom Expectations apply during our Zoom meetings. Act as if you are in class.
- Find a place away from distractions like noise, pets, and other devices.
- Sit at a table or desk where you'll be able to write.
- Keep yourself muted unless directed by the teacher to unmute yourself.
- Have your video on so the teacher can see you.
- Raise your hand in screen and virtually if you have a question or to add an on-topic comment.
- The chat can only be used for questions about the lesson or to answer questions asked by the teacher.
- Stay until the teacher ends the meeting.

Materials:

- Composition book for notes and classwork
- Pencils!! (mechanical or bring a handheld sharpener that catches shavings)
- Fully charged iPad and charger

Classwork (This includes work done for class on your at-home days.):

- I will grade classwork based on the **EFFORT** put into it. You must give an honest attempt for EVERY problem and **SHOW ALL WORK**.
- Work will be submitted via Google Classroom. Work can be done on your iPad (with a stylus and legible handwriting) or on paper. If using paper, you can take a clear photo with your iPad and upload it to Classroom.
- All work submitted should be your own work in your own handwriting.
- Assignments must be on time and complete! Late or incomplete assignments will be marked down (Late (L) = 75% and Incomplete (I) = 85%). Late assignments will be accepted until the end of the term.

Grading:

- A short quiz can be expected about once a week. These will most likely be on Wednesdays.
- Tests (or Quests) are given at the end of each unit.
- Students who earn a 75% or below on tests are required to make corrections and can increase their score up to a 75%.
- Students with exceptional classwork performance and participation may see their grade raised at the end of the term.

Extra Help (Office Hours):

- Your teacher should be your first resource and not your last resort!
